

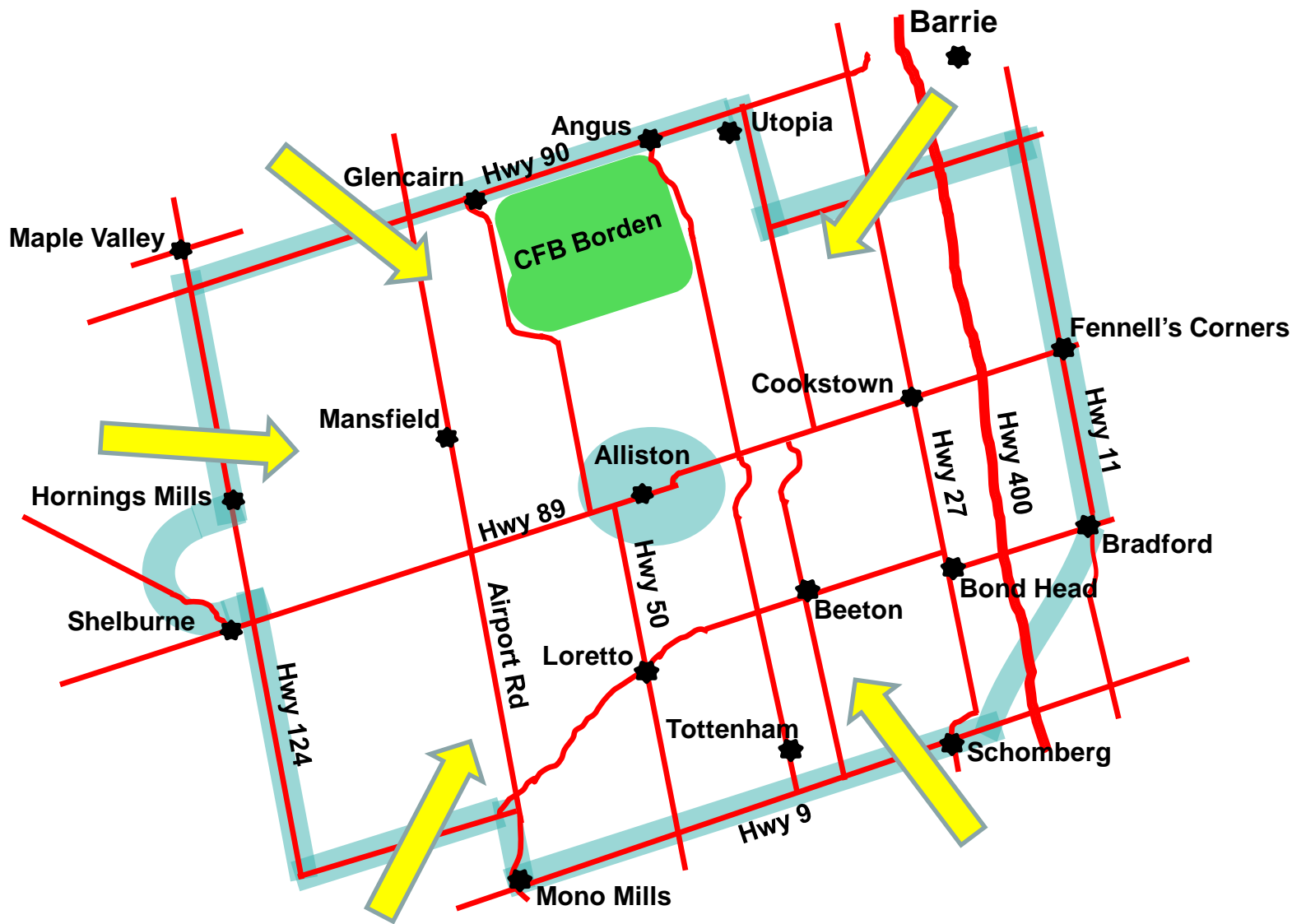


Stevenson Memorial Hospital

- ❖ Original Hospital opened in 1928
- ❖ T.P. Loblaw - tribute to his grandparents, William and Elizabeth Stevenson.
- ❖ Current building was built in 1964
- ❖ Services over 55,000 people a year from New Tecumseth, Essa, Innisfil, Adjala-Tosoronto and parts of 6 other townships.

Where does the money come from?



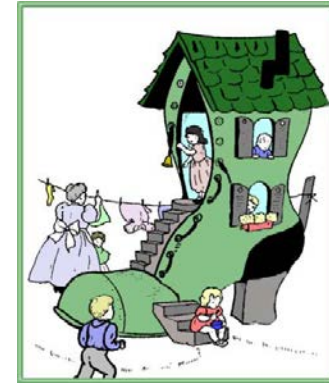
❖ A hospital is a Community Partnership

- ❖ 75% of households in our community utilize the hospital services

- ❖ Seamless service means some distinct procedures cannot be handled at Stevenson Memorial Hospital
- ❖ Patients will be transferred to Southlake Regional Health Centre, which has broader acute care capabilities

- ❖ Full Accreditation with Commendation from Accreditation Canada: Dec 2012
- ❖ The Birthing Unit has 100% patient satisfaction
- ❖ Emergency Room has some of the lowest wait times in Ontario
- ❖ The hospital has attracted enough Family Doctors to the Community for 100% patient service



The hospital faces three distinct challenges

An aging population requiring a higher proportion of healthcare services

65% population growth over the next 20 years (> 90,000)

A 50 year old structure with insufficient patient space

The Future Health Care Centre Committee is focusing on these challenges

The hospital has created the FHCCC to guide future infrastructure development

- Constrained by provincial budgets due to recession deficits
