Coming to the hospital



- When you arrive at Stevenson Memorial Hospital, please park in the visitor lot and proceed to the Emergency and Main Entrance.
- The Birthing Unit is located on the 1st Floor of the hospital.



Registration Desk



- Patients in active labour should register at the desk located at the main entrance.
- We offer direct communication with a registered nurse 24 hours a day for anyone needing labour and pregnancy support. Call:

Getting to the Birthing Unit



- When you leave the registration desk, turn left and proceed down the hallway, to the first right turn.
- If you require a wheelchair, they are available at the front entrance.

Signage to the Birthing Unit



- Turn right and follow the blue arrows to the next set of doors

Arriving at the Birthing Unit



- Walk through the double doors and turn left into the birthing unit. Continue following the blue arrow to the nursing station.

Nursing Station



- All patients arriving at the Birthing Unit are assessed by an experienced labour and delivery nurse.

Your Plan of Care



- Following assessment, the patient, nurse and physician or midwife will develop a plan of care based on the mother's condition.

Private Birthing Room



- When admitted, you will be given a private birthing room equipped with a birthing bed, fetal monitor and infant care system and private 3-piece washroom.
- A reclining chair is available for mother's partner.

1 on 1 nursing care

- Nurses provide 1 on 1 care during labour and combined care for mother and baby after birth.
- Your nurse will assist you and answer your questions and provide tips on baby care.



Caesarean Births available



- The safety of you and your baby is our top priority.
- If you require a Caesarean Birth, you will be taken to the OR.
- After the baby is born, you will spend 1-2 hours in a post-operative recovery before returning to the birthing unit.

After your delivery



- After delivery, your baby will be examined by a nurse and a physician and, in most cases, placed skin-to-skin with mother or father.
- An ID band matching Mom's wristband will be placed on the baby's ankle. Mom's partner will also receive an ID band.

Newborn Care

- Access to skilled paediatricians 24-7 for newborn care
